

**410-1-8-.06    Effective Date Of Decision**

No decision of the Certificate of Need Review Board shall be deemed final and become the final decision of SHPDA until fifteen (15) days following the date of the decision. In cases first heard before an Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"), the ALJ's proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law shall become final and the final decision of SHPDA fifteen (15) days after the recommended order is issued if no exceptions are filed.
